These two areas of vocations and formation will be addressed together because they go hand-in-hand; not only calling forth vocations to Consecrated life, but also growing the spirituality of those in the formation process. 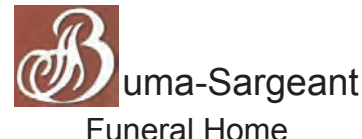
